



CHALLENGE: The Two You's

Steps:

- 1. What are your **Two You's?** For example, past/present, present/future, alone/together, fast/slow, happy/sad, realistic/abstract, colorful/black+white
- 2. Sketch your **Two You's** on paper
- 3. Add colors-- you can use crayon, colored pencils, markers, collage
- 4. Draw symbols that add to the Two You's. For example, plants, animals, weather, sports, art materials, important objects






Manuel Beltran *My Two You's,* 2021 Paint, pencil on paper Dimensions



Artist Statement:



The Challenge: Design your own Map





Artist Statement:








Kusama-inspired Botanical Drawings




